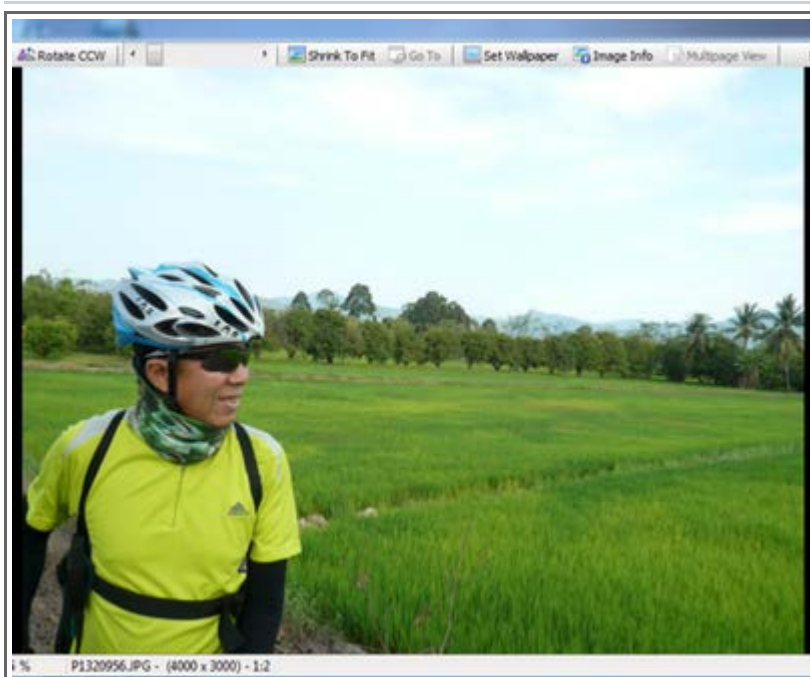

Hi Chawalit and Welcome,

Well for the Preview and Full Screen window you can change Zoom filter. Its in the Tools -> Options -> Preview and Full Screen tabs. Default is Linear. You could try ex. Lanczos3. But for the thumbnails there is different situation. If you have exif thumbnail included in that image then that is loaded instead of full image (faster loading, but sometimes thumbnails is not so sharp). You can try to uncheck that option: Tools -> Options -> Thumbview -> Use EXIF Extraction.

Yes its true that Viewer supports unicode filenames (partially only). Currently whole product is build with ansi only compiler, but some components what I use supports unicode filenames.

So:

- Viewer = partially unicode supported.
- Slide Show = no unicode support.
- Editor = no unicode support.
- Search = partially unicode supported.
- Profile Switcher = no unicode support.
- Multi Screen Viewer = no unicode support.

In your case Viewer tries to send unicode filename to Editor and Editor cannot handle properly that filename. Editor will try to open blank image instead.

I have plans to move product in to newer environment(IDE)/compiler what can handle unicode properly. But that takes time. Anyway, Viewer is needed to rewrite. When doing that I will transform (Slide Show, Editor...) to unicode as well.

Can the application currently (or be modified) to play images in a slideshow against TWO monitors on the same computer where one of the monitors is in PORTRAIT mode and the other monitor is in LANDSCAPE mode and the software ONLY plays an image in one monitor at a time based on the overall image orientation?

So PORTRAIT images only go to the portrait monitor and LANDSCAPE images only go to the landscape monitor. The other monitor is blacked out.

I would like to present images as art in a slideshow on two large 50" plasma TV's mounted on a wall.

Your software does 90% of this already.

The only problem is when it changes monitors it exposes the desktop on the other one. Is there any way you could also modify the program to black out the other monitor so all we see is the image on one and black on the other?

Based on your collection here, you certainly have a strong command of the lighting and composition issues that come up in photography. If you are doing these shoots for friends, then you probably should only charge a nominal fee to them. However, if you are getting requests from professional organizations or individuals (i.e. for weddings, etc.), then you can charge them in one of two styles: either based on the total number of photos that you develop, or receiving commission based on the amount of time it takes to do the shoot. In your case, I would suggest the latter, since you have a set fee and simply multiply this figure by the total number of hours that you work on the shoot (note: this doesn't include time spent developing the photos). I would prefer not to suggest an actual figure, but let's say that you could charge between \$25-75/hr and then eventually you could charge more as you receive better publicity.

I'm my personal experience (i work at a computer repair shop) the best anti virus application is AVG Free which as the name suggests is completely free. I would recommend that you use this in combination with Spybot Search and Destroy which again is free.

I find that in general many of the paid Internet Security suites such as Norton and McAfee use a lot of system resources and therefore can significantly slow your laptop down.

The new latest version of AVG includes an add in for your web browser that warns you if you attempt to visit a website that is likely to infect your computer. This can be quite useful to prevent you getting viruses in the first place. AVG is updated very regularly so that it recognises the latest viruses.

Despite it being free in my experience it has been easily as effective, if not more so than the major paid Anti-Virus products.
