Under Custom Show tab:

1. Click More and select Custom Show List Editor
2. With Add to List, you can add what images you want to shown in Custom Show.
3. Arrange list with Up and Down arrow buttons
4. If you want you can also add some custom style etc, choose style number.. and then click Change.
5. Click Apply, this will bring list back to main window
6. Start Show or you can Save that Custom Show list with More..

Inserting titles:

Slide Show supports EXIF information to display titles. You can edit titles with Viewer, Image Info. And then with Slide Show, Under Image Info tab, inserting what info you want show.

Hi, I have downloaded wildbit viewer from cnet/download.com and get a warning from my avg full version anti-virus software that the saved executable file contains 3 files of level 4 malware so I quarantined and then deleted the file.

Downloaded again with the same result.

I ran a pc scan with avg and then another with malwarebytes and all was fine.

Then tried to download wildbit viewer from softpedia.com, this time the software installed ok but as soon as I clicked on a wildbit desktop icon avg kicks-in with the same malware warning. I have downloaded different software after this happened and have had no problems. This is the first time I have had a malware warning from downloaded software. Has anyone had a similar problem?

I will admit I might not have read all of the support or help info possible, but I wanted to ask about a few capabilities that I was hoping to find. I am using the slideshow function with a custom show list.

I found many options for desktop wallpaper(strech, centered, smart...) but was hoping that those sorts of options would be available for slideshows, is that there somewhere?

There is also a new feature I am interested in, when a image is portrait oriented find another portrait image in the list and display them on the same screen next to one another. The goal is to do a better job of filling a landscape screen when the images are portrait. I have not seen this anywhere, but Wildbit has a feature to selectively direct images to different monitors dependant on portrait or landscape orientation so maybe the feature would be partly supported by the current ability to use the orientation.

You are right about the differing sizes for the combining of portrait oriented images, I had not thought about it. I would think it would be pretty valuable even if it were limited to only working if a same size image could be found to pair up. It seems that you already do some variety of stretching (with maintained aspect ratio) in the current slideshow, although I just noticed that I had started a show with it filling the screen nicely, but it has reverted back to centering a small version of the images unexpectedly. I don't know what caused that, I haven't stopped the show or changed anything?

Just for your background understanding, I am using Wildbit Slideshow to drive a second monitor mounted in another room inside a pictureframe as a changing photo display in a living room. I am sure you have seen the little digital frames which have finally become available as large as 8x10, but still costing at least \$200. My wife and I had wanted a "digital picture frame" for a long time, but it is for a semi formal room where a 16x20 or even larger size would be appropriate. Well I have not found that large of LCD unless I were to just get a HDTV, but that is more money, more power consumption and bulkier and I really don't want the TV features in this room anyway. I finally got a 23" LCD monitor for about \$150 and we are pretty happy with it. The computer to drive it is already located in another room just behind the wall running home security software. Just still looking for the ideal software to drive it and Wildbit is my favorite right now.

hmm. If you make about 2600 collage images. I can see that takes little bit of time. But the space problem is not so big issue. You don't need to make big collage images. You need only to save those as 23" monitor screen size. Yes I know that people wants to control what images are combined together. So best is to make collage images first and then display collage images in Slide Show.

About the resizing. Actually I have not tried what is maximum enlargement. I mean that enlargements is handled by component. Tough question actually, sorry. Also it will depends on user hardware.

But anyway when you are enlarge images you can enlarge images to certain point. Cause enlargement makes images as blurry/distorted etc. if you enlarge image too much. Small enlargement is pretty okay.

I think that I have reached point where rewriting is needed for Viewer. Main reasons for doing this is: I can't move on to next Delphi version, cause I'm stuck with one component series. New version of that component promises more faster thumbnail creation, grouping etc. Moving to new Delphi version brings full unicode support as well 😊

Also this means Search program is also needed rewriting (partly). Note! this means that the Slide Show, Editor are also unicode supported.

So maybe its time to redesign UI (interface) also. So do you want it to be customizable as much as user can? Or can it be "tight package" like it is now.

Anyway when its more customizable it may expose more design errors than "tight package" can be. 😊

Anyway this rewriting/redesigning is going to be long project and don't know when I start this..
